Singita Grumeti

Location of Singita Grumeti [A]

Spanning over 350,000 acres of untouched wilderness, Singita Grumeti is located in northern Tanzania, forming part of the Serengeti Mara ecosystem. Singita Explore Mobile Tented Camp is ideally positioned on the renowned migratory route traversed annually by more than a million wildebeest.

Without a doubt this is the most authentic “roughing-it in great style” experience the Serengeti has to offer. Inspired by the utility of overland gear Singita Explore Mobile Tented Camp is particularly appealing to those in search of an opportunity to connect up-close with the earth and wildlife in a way they have never done before. Despite being robust, the camp touches the earth lightly as it is pitched in remote locations across 350,000 private acres of Singita Grumeti in northern Tanzania.



What you need to know

Best time to go on Safari

East Africa is equatorial so the climate is fairly constant and it is a year-round destination. Tanzania has a light rain season from November to March. This period is known as the 'short rains', often no more than a quick downpour each day, followed by clear sunshine. From December to March the weather becomes increasingly warmer with the 'long rains' occurring between April and May.

Seasonal Temperatures

The above temperatures are the monthly average. The absolute temperatures differ from these temperatures.

Your Packing Guide

Cotton clothing in neutral colours is recommended for game drives and bush walks. It is advisable to avoid white and dark colours as they tend to attract certain bugs. No formal wear is required at any of our lodges.

Seasons dictate comfort and comfort dictates clothing, so we recommend that you pack as follows:

- October – April: Casual summer clothes (shorts and cool shirts) and a light sweater/fleece for the cooler morning and evening temperatures
- May – September: Casual light clothing and a light sweater/fleece for the cooler mornings and nights

It is a good idea to bring along the following items to ensure a carefree safari:

- Comfortable walking shoes/track shoes/hiking boots for walks; and sandals to wear around the lodge
- Swimming costume/bathing suits, sun block, sun hat, sunglasses, lip balm, mosquito repellent (The latter two items are provided but you are welcome to bring along your favourite brand)
- Video camera, camera, binoculars, spare memory cards

Please note that in the event of rain during a game drive, waterproof ponchos will be provided.

What you need to know

Health Requirements

Singita Explore Mobile Tented Camp operates in a malarial zone so it is essential to consider taking appropriate prophylactics. Yellow fever is present in Tanzania and inoculations are compulsory prior to entering East Africa. We recommended that you consult your doctor/physician before travelling.

Accommodation

- 6 x 1-bedroom tents configured to suit each individual group of travellers

This is an exclusive-use camp so it is pitched and set-up based on the requirements of each booking.

Amenities and Services

- There is no swimming pool as this is a mobile camp
- Spa treatments can be pre-arranged
- Dependent upon area coverage, there is mobile phone signal
- Electricity/power available: 240 VAC in the main lounge tent only. This is suitable for charging electronic devices
- Children of all ages are welcome as this is an exclusive-use experience. Activities are tailored to suit each family. For the interest of safety, children's participation in game activities is at the discretion of your guide

Activities

- Walking safaris, daytime game drives and spot lit night drives with professional guides
- Meals around the campfire

Key species you are likely to see

During your camping experience with Singita Explore, you are likely to spot a great variety of wildlife, including cheetah, bearded wildebeest, bat eared fox, black rhino, Maasai giraffe, lion, elephant, buffalo and leopard.
